Dear Parent/Carer

From Monday 17th July to Friday 21st July students will be engaged in our Enrichment Week. This will involve students participating in different activities and as such the times of the school day will be altered. The outline schedule is as follows:

Monday 17th July:	Secret Cinema Day	Students to dress as 'Muggles' (everyday clothes) or in fancy dress as witches and wizards. Students must not wear short skirts, crop tops or strappy tops. Students will finish at 3pm.
Tuesday 18th July:	Sports Day (at The Folkestone Academy)	Students to wear their House top and PE skort/shorts and will finish at approximately 3pm.
Wednesday 19th July:	House Day	Students to wear their House top and PE skort/shorts and will finish at 2.30pm.
Thursday 20th July:*	Society Day	Students to wear their House top and PE skort/shorts and will finish at 3pm.
Friday 21st July:	Final Day	Students to wear their full school uniform and will finish at 1pm.

**On the Society Day the Art Society students will be taught at the Glassworks Sixth Form Centre which is located in the town centre. Students can either meet and be dismissed from there, or they will be transported via minibus from the main site. Further information will be provided in due course.*

The bus companies are unable to accommodate our earlier finish, and students who normally travel to school by bus are encouraged to make their own arrangements. However if this is not possible they will be supervised until 5pm. If you are collecting your child from the main Academy it is important that you are aware that the Primary Academy finishes at 3.15pm, therefore the car park may be busy. We would recommend that you use the car park and walk from Sainsbury's to avoid undue congestion.

Students are required to bring their Academy planner with them every day during Enrichment Week. Failure to bring their planner will result in them being unable to enjoy the activities with their peers.

Further information on these days, particularly the House Days, will be provided to students later in the term.
